Alternatives in case you're stuck

If you're able to walk, this may be the easiest option. Glasgow isn't a big city and the city centre to the SEC is around a 35-40 minute walk.

While Glasgow has night buses, they only run on Friday and Saturday nights and even the best route [McGills' N38](#) does not run particularly often or close to the SEC.

The best option may be a taxi – either a black cab from one of the city centre cab ranks, or Uber or GlasGo private hire cabs.
